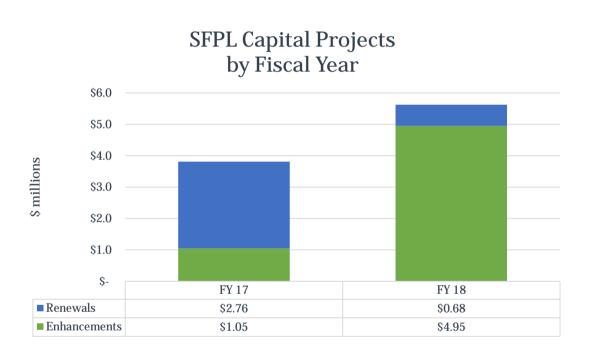


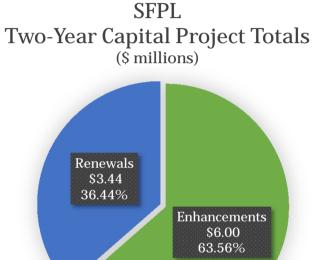

SFPL Funded Capital Projects – Major Uses

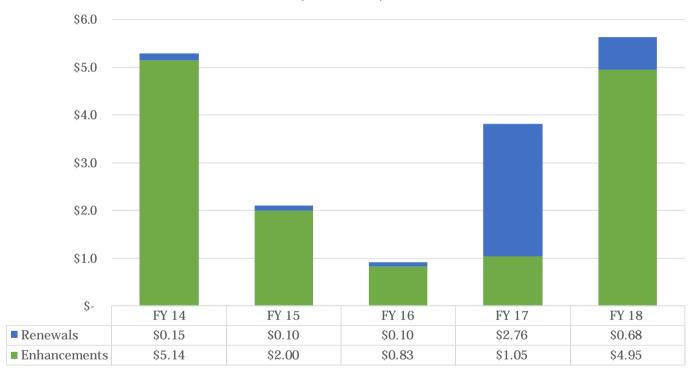
SFPL capital projects are funded by the Library Preservation Fund

SFPL Funded Capital Projects - Enhancements

Expanding the branch library vision

- Renovate three branch libraries to address changing community needs:
 - ✓ Oceanview
 - ✓ Mission
 - ✓ Chinatown
- o Initial projected program costs \$30.60M
- Projected program timeline FY 17-FY 22
- o FY 17 branch library renovation scoping \$0.90M
- o FY 18 branch renovation conceptual design/bid documents \$4.95M
- FY 19 start construction



SFPL Funded Capital Projects – Enhancements cont.

Efficiency & Sustainability Investments

- o Partnering with the PUC for Main Library LEED Gold certification
 - ✓ FY 17 initial investment \$0.05M
- o Investing in an additional automated library materials handling system for branch delivery services
 - ✓ FY 17 initial investment \$0.10M





SFPL Funded Capital Projects - Renewals

Reinvesting in SFPL facilities & systems

- o Roofing renewals
 - ✓ Main Library FY 17 \$1.40M
 - ✓ Support Services Facilities FY 18 \$0.18M
- o Main Library elevator renewal program
 - ✓ FY 17 \$0.05M to elevator consultant
 - ✓ FY 18 \$0.50M to begin renewal program
- HVAC replacement
 - ✓ Mission branch library FY 17 \$0.26M
 - ✓ Support Services Facilities FY17 \$0.95M
- o Main Library seismic joint repair FY 17 \$0.10M

Notes:

- (1) SFPL anticipates funding its horizon projects in future fiscal years with the Library Preservation Fund.
- (2) The elevator renewal program in the table above is net of the FY 17 & FY 18 investments.
- (3) As stated previously, the branch renovation program timeline for the Oceanview, Mission & Chinatown branches is estimated to be FY 17 FY 22 & initial program cost estimates are approximately \$30.6M.

Recent SFPL Capital Projects



Branch Library Improvement Program

- o Program Scope
 - ✓ Sixteen branch renovations
 - ✓ Eight new branch library facilities, including a new branch library in Mission Bay
 - ✓ One Support Services Facility
- Sources \$196.3M:
 - √ \$115.8M general obligation bonds and bond interest
 - ✓ \$34.1M lease revenue bonds
 - ✓ \$9.7M State monies
 - ✓ \$18.4M Library Preservation Fund
 - ✓ \$16.0M Friends of San Francisco Public Library
 - ✓ \$2.3M Miscellaneous Other sources
- Estimated final program cost \$190.1M
- BLIP return on investment between \$5.19 & \$9.11 for every dollar spent
