4 Resolution authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$90,000,000 aggregate 5 principal amount of one or more series of bonds on a tax-exempt or taxable basis of 6 City and County of San Francisco General Obligation Bonds (Earthquake Safety and 7 Emergency Response, 2020), Series 2021E; prescribing the form and terms of such 8 bonds and any subseries designation; providing for the appointment of depositories 9 and other agents for such bonds; providing for the establishment of accounts and/or 10 subaccounts related to such bonds; authorizing the sale of such bonds by competitive or negotiated sale; approving the forms of the Official Notice of Sale and Notice of 11 12 Intention to Sell Bonds and directing the publication of the Notice of Intention to Sell 13 Bonds; approving the form of the Purchase Contract; approving the form of the 14 Preliminary Official Statement and the execution of the Official Statement relating to 15 the sale of such bonds; approving the form of the Continuing Disclosure Certificate; 16 authorizing and approving modifications to such documents; ratifying certain actions 17 previously taken, as defined herein; and granting general authority to City officials to take necessary actions in connection with the authorization, issuance, sale, and 18 19 delivery of such bonds, as defined herein.

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21 WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 280-19, adopted by the Board of Supervisors ("Board of 22 Supervisors") of the City and County of San Francisco ("City") on June 11, 2019, and signed 23 by the Mayor ("Mayor") on June 21, 2019, it was determined and declared that public interest 24 and necessity demand the construction, acquisition, improvement, renovation, and seismic 25 retrofitting of the Emergency Firefighting Water System, firefighting facilities and infrastructure, police facilities and facilities and infrastructure, facilities for the Department of
Emergency Management's 911 Call Center, and other disaster response facilities and
infrastructure for earthquake and public safety, and related costs necessary or convenient
therein described ("Project"); and

5 WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 159-19 passed by the Board of Supervisors on July 9, 6 2019, and signed by the Mayor on July 11, 2019 ("Bond Ordinance"), the Board of 7 Supervisors duly called a special election to be held on March 3, 2020 ("Bond Election"), for 8 the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City a proposition to incur bonded 9 indebtedness of the City in the amount of \$628,500,000 to finance the Project, and such 10 proposition was approved by two-thirds of the qualified voters of the City voting on such 11 proposition, and declaration of such Bond Election results was made by the Board of 12 Supervisors pursuant to Resolution No. 150-20 on April 7, 2020, and approved by the Mayor 13 on April 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 023-21, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on
January 26, 2021 and approved by the Mayor on February 5, 2021 ("Authorizing Resolution"),
the City was authorized to issue its General Obligation Bonds (Earthquake Safety and
Emergency Response, 2020) in one or more series or subseries on a tax-exempt or taxable
basis (collectively, "Bonds") in the not-to-exceed amount of \$628,500,000; and

WHEREAS, On March 30, 2021 the City issued its first series of Bonds in the amount
of \$80,715,000 to finance the Project; and

21 WHEREAS, It is necessary and desirable to issue the second series of the Bonds in 22 one or more subseries on a tax-exempt or taxable basis, in an aggregate principal amount not 23 to exceed \$90,000,000 (collectively, "Series 2021E Bonds"), to finance a portion of the costs 24 of the Project; and

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WHEREAS, The Series 2021E Bonds are being issued pursuant to the Authorizing
 Resolution and Title 5, Division 2, Part 1, Chapter 3, Article 4.5 of the California Government
 Code ("Government Code"), the City Charter ("Charter"), the Bond Ordinances and the Bond
 Election; and

5 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the San Francisco Administrative 6 Code ("Administrative Code") Sections 5.30-5.36, the Citizens' General Obligation Bond 7 Oversight Committee shall conduct an annual review of bond spending and shall provide an 8 annual report on the management of the program to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors, 9 and, to the extent permitted by law, one tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the gross proceeds of 10 the Series 2021E Bonds shall be deposited in a fund established by the Office of the City 11 Controller ("Controller") and appropriated by the Board of Supervisors at the direction of the 12 Citizens' General Obligation Bond Oversight Committee to cover the costs of such committee 13 and its review process; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of the City and
 County of San Francisco, as follows:

16 Section 1. Recitals. All of the recitals in this Resolution are true and correct. 17 Section 2. Conditions Precedent. All conditions, things and acts required by law to 18 exist, to happen and to be performed precedent to and in connection with the issuance of the 19 Series 2021E Bonds and any subseries thereof exist, have happened and have been 20 performed in due time, form and manner in accordance with applicable law, and the City is 21 now authorized pursuant to the Bond Election, the Authorizing Resolution, the Charter and 22 applicable law to incur indebtedness in the manner and form provided in this Resolution. 23 Section 3. Documents. The documents presented to the Board of Supervisors and on 24 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors or designee thereof ("Clerk of the Board of 25 Supervisors") are contained in File No.

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Section 4. <u>Issuance and Sale of Series 2021E Bonds; Determination of Certain Terms;</u>
 <u>Designation</u>. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the issuance and sale of not to exceed
 \$90,000,000 in aggregate principal amount of Bonds to be designated as "City and County of
 San Francisco General Obligation Bonds (Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response,
 2020) Series 2021E [and any subseries designation]," for the purposes set forth in the Bond
 Ordinances and Proposition B approved by the voters at the Bond Election.

7 The City Director of Public Finance or a designee thereof ("Director of Public Finance") 8 is authorized to determine, for the Series 2021E Bonds, the sale date, the interest rates, the 9 definitive principal amount, the maturity dates and the redemption dates, if any, and the terms 10 of any optional or mandatory redemption, subject to the other specific provisions of this 11 Resolution, including the following terms and conditions: (a) the Series 2021E Bonds shall not 12 have a true interest cost (as such term is defined in the Official Notice of Sale (as defined in 13 Section 13) for the Series 2021E Bonds) in excess of 12%; and (b) the Series 2021E Bonds 14 may have a duration up to 30 years from their date of issuance. The Director of Public 15 Finance is further authorized to give the Series 2021E Bonds such additional or other series 16 or subseries designation, or to modify such series or subseries designation, as may be 17 necessary or appropriate to distinguish the Series 2021E Bonds and any subseries thereof 18 from every other series or subseries of Bonds and from other bonds issued by the City, and in 19 the event the Series 2021E Bonds shall consist of multiple series of subseries, there may be 20 one or more maturities in the first year following the issuance of the Series 2021E Bonds, 21 which maturity dates may be determined by the Director of Public Finance. 22 Section 5. Authentication and Registration of the Series 2021E Bonds. Each of the 23 Series 2021E Bonds shall be in fully registered form without coupons in denominations of 24 \$5,000 or any integral multiple of that amount. The officers of the City are directed to cause

the Series 2021E Bonds to be prepared in sufficient quantity for delivery to or for the account

1 of their purchaser and the Controller or the Director of Public Finance is directed to cause the 2 blanks in the Series 2021E Bonds to be completed in accordance with the Authorizing 3 Resolution, this Resolution, and the Bond Award or Purchase Contract (each as defined 4 below), to procure their execution by the proper officers of the City (including by facsimile 5 signature if necessary or convenient, except that any signature for the Clerk of the Board of 6 Supervisors shall be required to be by manual signature) and authentication as provided in 7 this Section, and to deliver the Series 2021E Bonds when so executed and authenticated to 8 the purchaser in exchange for the purchase price, all in accordance with the Authorizing 9 Resolution.

10 The Series 2021E Bonds and the certificate of authentication and registration, to be 11 manually executed by the City Treasurer or designee thereof ("City Treasurer"), and the form 12 of assignment to appear on the Series 2021E Bonds shall be substantially in the form 13 attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> (a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and 14 which is declared to be a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Resolution), with 15 necessary or appropriate variations, omissions and insertions as permitted or required by this 16 Resolution.

Only Series 2021E Bonds bearing a certificate of authentication and registration
 executed by the City Treasurer shall be valid or obligatory for any purpose or entitled to the
 benefits of the Authorizing Resolution and this Resolution, and such certificate of the City
 Treasurer, executed as provided in this Resolution, shall be conclusive evidence that the
 Series 2021E Bonds so authenticated have been duly authenticated and delivered under, and
 are entitled to the benefits of, the Authorizing Resolution and this Resolution.
 The Controller shall assign a distinctive letter, or number, or letter and number to each

23 The Controller shall assign a distinctive letter, or number, or letter and number to each 24 Series 2021E Bond authenticated and registered by the City Treasurer and shall maintain a 25 record thereof which shall be available for inspection.

1 Section 6. Registration Books. The City Treasurer shall keep or cause to be kept, at 2 the office of the City Treasurer or at the designated office of any registrar appointed by the 3 City Treasurer, separate and sufficient books for the registration and transfer of Series 2021E 4 Bonds, which books shall at all times be open to inspection, and upon presentation for such 5 purpose, the City Treasurer shall, under such reasonable regulations as he or she may 6 prescribe, register or transfer or cause to be registered or transferred, on such books, Series 7 2021E Bonds as provided in this Resolution. The City and the City Treasurer may treat the 8 registered owner of each Series 2021E Bond as its absolute owner for all purposes, and the 9 City and the City Treasurer shall not be affected by any notice to the contrary.

10 Section 7. <u>Transfer or Exchange of Series 2021E Bonds</u>. Any Series 2021E Bond 11 may, in accordance with its terms, be transferred upon the books required to be kept pursuant 12 to the provisions of Section 6, by the person in whose name it is registered, in person or by 13 the duly authorized attorney of such person in writing, upon surrender of such Series 2021E 14 Bond for cancellation, accompanied by delivery of a duly executed written instrument of 15 transfer in a form approved by the City Treasurer.

Any Series 2021E Bond may be exchanged at the office of the City Treasurer for a like aggregate principal amount of other authorized denominations of the same interest rate and maturity.

Whenever any Series 2021E Bond shall be surrendered for transfer or exchange, the designated City officials shall execute (as provided in Section 5) and the City Treasurer shall authenticate and deliver a new Series 2021E Bond of the same interest rate and maturity in a like aggregate principal amount. The City Treasurer shall require the payment by any bond owner requesting any such transfer of any tax or other governmental charge required to be paid with respect to such transfer or exchange.

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No transfer or exchange of Series 2021E Bonds shall be required to be made by the
 City Treasurer during the period from the Record Date (as defined in Section 8(b)) next
 preceding each interest payment date to such interest payment date or after a notice of
 redemption shall have been mailed with respect to such Series 2021E Bonds.

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Section 8. <u>Terms of the Series 2021E Bonds; General Redemption Provisions</u>.

6 (a) <u>Date of the Series 2021E Bonds</u>. The Series 2021E Bonds shall be dated the 7 date of their delivery or such other date ("Dated Date") as is specified in the Bond Award or 8 the Purchase Contract.

9 (b) <u>Payment of the Series 2021E Bonds</u>. The principal of the Series 2021E Bonds 10 shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America to their owners, upon 11 surrender at maturity or earlier redemption at the office of the City Treasurer. The interest on 12 the Series 2021E Bonds shall be payable in like lawful money to the person whose name 13 appears on the bond registration books of the City Treasurer as the owner as of the close of 14 business on the last day of the month immediately preceding an interest payment date 15 ("Record Date"), whether or not such day is a Business Day (as defined below).

16 Except as may be otherwise provided in connection with any book-entry-only system 17 applicable to the Series 2021E Bonds, payment of the interest on any Series 2021E Bond 18 shall be made by check mailed on the interest payment date to such owner at such owner's 19 address as it appears on the registration books as of the Record Date; provided, that if any 20 interest payment date occurs on a day that banks in California or New York are closed for 21 business or the New York Stock Exchange is closed for business, then such payment shall be 22 made on the next succeeding day that banks in both California and New York are open for 23 business and the New York Stock Exchange is open for business (each, a "Business Day"); 24 and provided, further, that the registered owner of an aggregate principal amount of at least 25 \$1,000,000 of Series 2021E Bonds may submit a written request to the City Treasurer on or

before a Record Date preceding an interest payment date for payment of interest on the next
 succeeding interest payment date and thereafter by wire transfer to a commercial bank
 located within the United States of America.

For so long as any Series 2021E Bonds are held in book-entry form by a securities
depository selected by the City pursuant to Section 10, payment shall be made to the
registered owner of the Series 2021E Bonds designated by such securities depository by wire
transfer of immediately available funds.

8 (c) Interest on the Series 2021E Bonds. The Series 2021E Bonds shall bear interest 9 at rates to be determined upon the sale of the Series 2021E Bonds, calculated on the basis of 10 a 360-day year comprised of twelve 30-day months, payable on December 15, 2021 (or such 11 other date as may be designated in the Bond Award or Purchase Contract), and semiannually 12 thereafter on June 15 and December 15 of each year. Each Series 2021E Bond shall bear 13 interest from the interest payment date next preceding the date of its authentication unless it 14 is authenticated as of a day during the period from the Record Date next preceding any 15 interest payment date to the interest payment date, inclusive, in which event it shall bear 16 interest from such interest payment date, or unless it is authenticated on or before the first 17 Record Date, in which event it shall bear interest from the Dated Date; provided, that if, at the 18 time of authentication of any Series 2021E Bond, interest is in default on the Series 2021E 19 Bonds, such Series 2021E Bond shall bear interest from the interest payment date to which 20 interest has previously been paid or made available for payment on the Series 2021E Bonds 21 or from the Dated Date if the first interest payment is not made.

(d) <u>Optional Redemption</u>. The Series 2021E Bonds shall be subject to optional
 redemption prior to maturity as shall be provided in the Official Notice of Sale or the Purchase
 Contract, as applicable.

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(e) <u>Mandatory Redemption</u>. The Series 2021E Bonds shall be subject to mandatory
 redemption as shall be designated by the purchaser pursuant to the terms of the Official
 Notice of Sale or as designated in the Purchase Contract, as applicable.

4 The principal of and interest on the Series 2021E Bonds subject to mandatory 5 redemption shall be paid from the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount established in Section 9, 6 pursuant to Section 9. In lieu of any such mandatory redemption for Series 2021E Bonds, at 7 any time prior to the selection of Series 2021E Bonds for mandatory redemption, the City may 8 apply amounts on deposit in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount to make such payment to 9 the purchase, at public or private sale, of Series 2021E Bonds subject to such mandatory 10 redemption, and when and at such prices not in excess of the principal amount thereof 11 (including sales commission and other charges but excluding accrued interest), as the City 12 may determine.

(f) <u>Selection of Series 2021E Bonds for Redemption</u>. Whenever less than all of the
outstanding Series 2021E Bonds are called for redemption on any date, the Director of Public
Finance will select the maturities of the Series 2021E Bonds to be redeemed in the sole
discretion of the Director of Public Finance. Whenever less than all of the outstanding Series
2021E Bonds maturing on any one date are called for redemption, the manner of selection of
the portion of such Series 2021E Bonds called for redemption shall be as specified in the
Official Statement for the Series 2021E Bonds.

(g) <u>Notice of Redemption</u>. The date on which Series 2021E Bonds that are called
 for redemption are to be presented for redemption is called the "Redemption Date." The City
 Treasurer shall mail, or cause to be mailed, notice of any redemption of Series 2021E Bonds,
 postage prepaid, to the respective registered owners at the addresses appearing on the bond
 registration books not less than 20 nor more than 60 days prior to the Redemption Date. The
 notice of redemption shall: (i) state the Redemption Date; (ii) state the redemption price; (iii)

1 state the maturity dates of the Series 2021E Bonds to be redeemed and, if less than all of any 2 such maturity is called for redemption, the distinctive numbers of the Series 2021E Bonds of 3 such maturity to be redeemed, and in the case of any Series 2021E Bonds to be redeemed in 4 part only, the respective portions of the principal amount to be redeemed; (iv) state the CUSIP 5 number, if any, of each Series 2021E Bond to be redeemed; (v) require that such Series 6 2021E Bonds be surrendered by the owners at the office of the City Treasurer or his or her 7 agent: and (vi) give notice that interest on such Series 2021E Bonds or portions of Series 8 2021E Bonds to be redeemed will cease to accrue after the Redemption Date. Notice of 9 optional redemption may be conditional upon receipt of funds or other event specified in the 10 notice of redemption as provided in Section 8(j) below.

11 The actual receipt by the owner of any Series 2021E Bond of notice of such 12 redemption shall not be a condition precedent to redemption, and failure to receive such 13 notice, or any defect in such notice so mailed, shall not affect the validity of the proceedings 14 for the redemption of such Series 2021E Bonds or the cessation of accrual of interest on such 15 Series 2021E Bonds on the Redemption Date. Notice of redemption also shall be given, or 16 caused to be given by the City Treasurer, by: (i) registered or certified mail, postage prepaid; 17 (ii) confirmed facsimile transmission; (iii) overnight delivery service; or (iv) to the extent 18 acceptable to the intended recipient, email or similar electronic means, to (A) all organizations 19 registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission as securities depositories, and (B) 20 such other services or organizations as may be required in accordance with the Continuing 21 Disclosure Certificate described in Section 18. 22 The notice or notices required for redemption shall be given by the City Treasurer or

any agent appointed by the City. A certificate of the City Treasurer or such other appointed
 agent of the City that notice of redemption has been given to the owner of any Series 2021E
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Bond to be redeemed in accordance with this Resolution shall be conclusive against all
 parties.

3 (h) Series 2021E Redemption Account. At the time the Director of Public Finance 4 determines to optionally call and redeem any of the Series 2021E Bonds, the Controller or his 5 or her agent shall establish a redemption account to be described or known as the "General 6 Obligation Bonds (Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response, 2020), Series 2021E 7 Redemption Account" ("Series 2021E Redemption Account"), and prior to or on the 8 Redemption Date there must be set aside in the Series 2021E Redemption Account moneys 9 available for the purpose and sufficient to redeem, as provided in this Resolution, the Series 10 2021E Bonds designated in such notice of redemption, subject to the provisions of Section 11 8(j) below. Such moneys must be set aside in the Series 2021E Redemption Account solely 12 for the purpose of, and shall be applied on or after the Redemption Date to, payment of the 13 redemption price of the Series 2021E Bonds to be redeemed upon presentation and 14 surrender of such Series 2021E Bonds. Any interest due on or prior to the Redemption Date 15 may be paid from the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount as provided in Section 9 or from the 16 Series 2021E Redemption Account. Moneys held from time to time in the Series 2021E 17 Redemption Account shall be invested by the City Treasurer pursuant to the City's policies 18 and guidelines for investment of moneys in the general fund ("General Fund") of the City. If, 19 after all of the Series 2021E Bonds have been redeemed and canceled or paid and canceled, 20 there are moneys remaining in the Series 2021E Redemption Account, such moneys shall be 21 transferred to the General Fund of the City or to such other fund or account as required by 22 applicable law; provided, that if such moneys are part of the proceeds of refunding bonds, 23 such moneys shall be transferred pursuant to the resolution authorizing such refunding bonds. 24 (i) Effect of Redemption. When notice of optional redemption has been given 25 substantially as provided in this Resolution, and when the amount necessary for the

1 redemption of the Series 2021E Bonds called for redemption (principal, premium, if any, and 2 accrued interest to such Redemption Date) is set aside for that purpose in the Series 2021E 3 Redemption Account, the Series 2021E Bonds designated for redemption shall become due 4 and payable on the Redemption Date, and upon presentation and surrender of such Series 5 2021E Bonds at the place specified in the notice of redemption, such Series 2021E Bonds 6 shall be redeemed and paid at the redemption price out of the Series 2021E Redemption 7 Account. No interest will accrue on such Series 2021E Bonds called for redemption after the 8 Redemption Date and the registered owners of such Series 2021E Bonds shall look for 9 payment of such Series 2021E Bonds only to the Series 2021E Redemption Account. All 10 Series 2021E Bonds redeemed shall be canceled immediately by the City Treasurer and shall 11 not be reissued.

12 (i) Conditional Notice of Redemption; Rescission of Redemption. Any notice of 13 optional redemption given as provided in Section 8(g) may provide that such redemption is 14 conditioned upon: (i) deposit in the Series 2021E Redemption Account of sufficient moneys to 15 redeem the Series 2021E Bonds called for optional redemption on the anticipated 16 Redemption Date, or (ii) the occurrence of any other event specified in the notice of 17 redemption. If conditional notice of redemption has been given substantially as provided in 18 this clause, and on the scheduled Redemption Date (A) sufficient moneys to redeem the 19 Series 2021E Bonds called for optional redemption on the Redemption Date have not been 20 deposited in the Series 2021E Redemption Account, or (B) any other event specified in the 21 notice of redemption as a condition to the redemption has not occurred, then (1) the Series 22 2021E Bonds for which conditional notice of redemption was given shall not be redeemed on 23 the anticipated Redemption Date and shall remain outstanding for all purposes of this 24 Resolution, and (2) the redemption not occurring shall not constitute a default under this 25 Resolution or the Authorizing Resolution.

1 The City may rescind any optional redemption and notice of it for any reason on any 2 date prior to any Redemption Date by causing written notice of the rescission to be given to 3 the owners of all Series 2021E Bonds so called for redemption. Notice of any such rescission 4 of redemption shall be given in the same manner notice of redemption was originally given.

5 The actual receipt by the owner of any Series 2021E Bond of notice of such rescission 6 shall not be a condition precedent to rescission, and failure to receive such notice or any 7 defect in such notice so mailed shall not affect the validity of the rescission.

8 Section 9. Series 2021E Bond Subaccount. There is established with the City 9 Treasurer a special subaccount in the General Obligation Bonds (Earthquake Safety and 10 Emergency Response, 2020) Series 2021E Bond Account ("Bond Account") created pursuant 11 to the Authorizing Resolution to be designated as the "General Obligation Bonds (Earthquake 12 Safety and Emergency Response, 2020), Series 2021E Bond Subaccount" and, in the event 13 the Series 2021E Bonds shall consist of multiple series or subseries, a special subaccount 14 therein for each such series or subseries (individually and collectively, "Series 2021E Bond 15 Subaccount"), to be held separate and apart from all other accounts of the City. All interest 16 earned on amounts on deposit in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount shall be retained in the 17 Series 2021E Bond Subaccount.

On or prior to the date on which any payment of principal of or interest on the Series 2021E Bonds is due, including any Series 2021E Bonds subject to mandatory redemption on such date, the City Treasurer shall allocate to and deposit in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount, from amounts held in the Bond Account, an amount which, when added to any available moneys contained in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount, is sufficient to pay principal of and interest on the Series 2021E Bonds on such date. On or prior to the date on which any Series 2021E Bonds are to be redeemed at the

25 option of the City pursuant to this Resolution, the City Treasurer may allocate to and deposit

in the Series 2021E Redemption Account, from amounts held in the Bond Account pursuant to
Section 8 of the Authorizing Resolution, an amount which, when added to any available
moneys contained in the Series 2021E Redemption Account, is sufficient to pay principal,
interest and premium, if any, with respect to such Series 2021E Bonds on such date. The
City Treasurer may make such other provision for the payment of principal of and interest and
any redemption premium on the Series 2021E Bonds as is necessary or convenient to permit
the optional redemption of the Series 2021E Bonds.

Amounts in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount may be invested in any investment of the City in which moneys in the General Fund of the City are or can be invested. The City Treasurer may (a) commingle any of the moneys held in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount with other City moneys, or (b) deposit amounts credited to the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount into a separate fund or funds for investment purposes only; provided, that all of the moneys held in the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount shall be accounted for separately notwithstanding any such commingling or separate deposit by the City Treasurer.

15 Section 10. Appointment of Depositories and Other Agents. The City Treasurer is 16 authorized and directed to appoint one or more depositories as he or she may deem desirable 17 and the procedures set forth in Section 5, Section 6, Section 7 and Section 8 relating to 18 registration of ownership of the Series 2021E Bonds and payments and redemption notices to 19 owners of the Series 2021E Bonds may be modified to comply with the policies and 20 procedures of such depository. The City will not have any responsibility or obligation to any 21 purchaser of a beneficial ownership interest in any Series 2021E Bonds or to any participants 22 in such a depository with respect to (a) the accuracy of any records maintained by such 23 securities depository or any participant therein; (b) any notice that is permitted or required to 24 be given to the owners of Series 2021E Bonds under this Resolution; (c) the selection by such 25 securities depository or any participant therein of any person to receive payment in the event

of a partial redemption of Series 2021E Bonds; (d) the payment by such securities depository
or any participant therein of any amount with respect to the principal or redemption premium,
if any, or interest due with respect to Series 2021E Bonds; (e) any consent given or other
action taken by such securities depository as the owner of Series 2021E Bonds; or (f) any
other matter.

6 The Depository Trust Company, New York New York ("DTC") is appointed as 7 depository for the Series 2021E Bonds. The Series 2021E Bonds shall be initially issued in 8 book-entry form. Upon initial issuance, the ownership of each Series 2021E Bond shall be 9 registered in the bond register in the name of Cede & Co., as nominee of DTC. So long as 10 each Series 2021E Bond is registered in book-entry form, each Series 2021E Bond shall be 11 registered in the name of Cede & Co. or in the name of such successor nominee as may be 12 designated from time to time by DTC or any successor as depository.

13 The City Treasurer is also authorized and directed to appoint one or more agents as he 14 or she may deem necessary or desirable, to the extent permitted by applicable law and under 15 the supervision of the City Treasurer, such agents may serve as paying agent, fiscal agent, 16 escrow agent or registrar for the Series 2021E Bonds or may assist the City Treasurer in 17 performing any or all of such functions and such other duties as the City Treasurer shall 18 determine. Such agents shall serve under such terms and conditions as the City Treasurer 19 shall determine. The City Treasurer may remove or replace agents appointed pursuant to this 20 paragraph at any time.

The Controller or the Director of Public Finance is also authorized and directed to appoint a rebate calculation agent as he or she may deem necessary or desirable. Such agent shall serve under such terms and conditions as the Controller or the Director of Public Finance shall determine. The Controller or the Director of Public Finance may remove or replace such agent appointed pursuant to this paragraph at any time. Section 11. <u>Defeasance Provisions</u>. Payment of all or any portion of the Series 2021E
 Bonds may be provided for prior to such Series 2021E Bonds' respective stated maturities by
 irrevocably depositing with the City Treasurer (or any commercial bank or trust company
 designated by the City Treasurer to act as escrow agent with respect thereto):

5 (a) an amount of cash equal to the principal amount of all of such Series 2021E 6 Bonds or a portion thereof, and all unpaid interest thereon to maturity, except that in the case 7 of Series 2021E Bonds which are to be redeemed prior to such Series 2021E Bonds' 8 respective stated maturities and in respect of which notice of such redemption shall have 9 been given as provided in Section 8 hereof or an irrevocable election to give such notice shall 10 have been made by the City, the amount to be deposited shall be the principal amount 11 thereof, all unpaid interest thereon to the Redemption Date, and any premium due on such 12 Redemption Date; or

13 (b) Defeasance Securities (as herein defined) not subject to call, except as provided 14 below in the definition thereof, maturing and paying interest at such times and in such 15 amounts; together with interest earnings and cash, if required, as will, without reinvestment, 16 as certified by an independent certified public accountant, be fully sufficient to pay the 17 principal and all unpaid interest to maturity, or to the Redemption Date, as the case may be, 18 and any premium due on the Series 2021E Bonds to be paid or redeemed, as such principal 19 and interest come due; provided, that, in the case of the Series 2021E Bonds which are to be 20 redeemed prior to maturity, notice of such redemption shall be given as provided in Section 8 21 hereof or an irrevocable election to give such notice shall have been made by the City; then, 22 all obligations of the City with respect to such outstanding Series 2021E Bonds shall cease 23 and terminate, except only the tax covenants under Section 23 and the obligation of the City 24 to pay or cause to be paid from the funds deposited pursuant to clause (a) or (b) of this 25 Section 11, to the owners of such Series 2021E Bonds all sums due with respect thereto; and

provided further, that the City shall have received an opinion of nationally recognized bond
 counsel, that provision for the payment of such Series 2021E Bonds has been made in
 accordance with this Section 11.

For purposes of this Section 11, "Defeasance Securities" shall mean any of the
following that at the time are legal investments under the laws of the State of California for the
moneys proposed to be invested therein:

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(i) United States Obligations (as defined below); and

8 (ii) Pre-refunded fixed interest rate municipal obligations meeting the 9 following conditions: (A) the municipal obligations are not subject to redemption prior to 10 maturity, or the trustee or paying agent has been given irrevocable instructions concerning 11 their calling and redemption and the issuer has covenanted not to redeem such obligations 12 other than as set forth in such instructions; (B) the municipal obligations are secured by cash 13 and/or United States Obligations; (C) the principal of and interest on the United States 14 Obligations (plus any cash in the escrow fund or the redemption account) are sufficient to 15 meet the liabilities of the municipal obligations; (D) the United States Obligations serving as 16 security for the municipal obligations are held by an escrow agent or trustee; (E) the United 17 States Obligations are not available to satisfy any other claims, including those against the 18 trustee or escrow agent; and (F) the municipal obligations are rated (without regard to any 19 numerical modifier, plus or minus sign or other modifier), at the time of original deposit to the 20 escrow fund, by any two Rating Agencies (as defined below) not lower than the rating then 21 maintained by such Rating Agencies on such United States Obligations.

For purposes of this Section 11, "United States Obligations" means (i) direct and general obligations of the United States of America, or obligations that are unconditionally guaranteed as to principal and interest by the United States of America, including, without limitation, the interest component of Resolution Funding Corporation ("REFCORP") bonds that have been stripped by request to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York in book-entry form
or (ii) any security issued by an agency or instrumentality of the United States of America that
is selected by the Director of Public Finance that results in the escrow fund being rated by any
two Rating Agencies, at the time of the initial deposit to the escrow fund and upon any
substitution or subsequent deposit to the escrow fund, not lower than the rating then
maintained by the respective Rating Agency on United States Obligations described in clause
(i) above.

8 For purposes of this Section 11, "Rating Agencies" shall mean Moody's Investors 9 Service, Fitch Ratings, S&P Global Ratings and Kroll Bond Rating Agency, LLC, or any other 10 nationally-recognized bond rating agency that is the successor to any of the foregoing rating 11 agencies or that is otherwise established after the date hereof.

Section 12. <u>Sale of Series 2021E Bonds By Competitive or Negotiated Sale</u>. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the sale of the Series 2021E Bonds by solicitation of competitive bids or by negotiated sale to one or more underwriters to be appointed in accordance with City policies, if so determined by the Director of Public Finance.

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Section 13. Official Notice of Sale; Receipt of Bids; Bond Award.

17 (a) Official Notice of Sale. If the Series 2021E Bonds are sold through a solicitation 18 of competitive bids, then the form of proposed Official Notice of Sale inviting bids for the Series 2021E Bonds ("Official Notice of Sale") submitted to the Board of Supervisors and on 19 20 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is approved and adopted as the Official Notice 21 of Sale inviting bids for the Series 2021E Bonds, with such changes, additions and 22 modifications as may be made in accordance with Section 19. The Director of Public Finance 23 is authorized and directed to cause to be mailed or otherwise circulated to prospective bidders 24 for the Series 2021E Bonds copies of the Official Notice of Sale, subject to such corrections, 25 revisions or additions as may be acceptable to the Director of Public Finance.

1 (b) Receipt of Bids. Bids shall be received on the sale date(s) designated by the 2 Director of Public Finance pursuant to Section 4.

3 (c) Bond Award. As provided in the Official Notice of Sale, the City may reject any 4 and all bids received for any reason. The Director of Public Finance or the Controller is 5 authorized to award the Series 2021E Bonds to the responsible bidder whose bid (i) is timely 6 received and conforms to the Official Notice of Sale, except to the extent informalities and 7 irregularities are waived by the City as permitted by the Official Notice of Sale; and (ii) 8 represents the lowest true interest cost to the City in accordance with the procedures 9 described in the Official Notice of Sale. The award, if made, shall be set forth in a certificate 10 signed by the Controller or Director of Public Finance setting forth the terms of the Series 11 2021E Bonds and the original purchasers ("Bond Award"). The Director of Public Finance 12 shall provide a copy of the Bond Award, if such award is not signed by the Controller, as soon 13 as practicable to the Controller; provided, that failure to provide such copy shall not affect the 14 validity of the Bond Award.

15 Section 14. Publication of Notice of Intention to Sell Bonds. If the Series 2021E Bonds 16 are sold through a solicitation of competitive bids, then the form of proposed Notice of 17 Intention to Sell the Series 2021E Bonds ("Notice of Intention to Sell Bonds") submitted to the 18 Board of Supervisors and on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is approved and 19 adopted as the Notice of Intention to Sell the Series 2021E Bonds, and the Director of Public 20 Finance is authorized and directed to cause the Notice of Intention to Sell Bonds, subject to 21 such corrections, revisions or additions as may be made in accordance with Section 19, to be 22 published once in The Bond Buyer or another financial publication generally circulated 23 throughout the State of California meeting the requirements of Section 53692 of the 24 Government Code at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for receipt of bids for the Series 25 2021E Bonds, or as otherwise set forth in Section 53692 of the Government Code.

1 Section 15. Authorization of Negotiated Sale; Authorization to Select Underwriters; 2 Form of Purchase Contract Approval. The Director of Public Finance, in consultation with the 3 Controller, is hereby authorized to conduct the sale of the Series 2021E Bonds by negotiated 4 sale pursuant to one or more Purchase Contracts (each, a "Purchase Contract"), each by and 5 between the City and the underwriter(s) named therein ("Underwriters"), if the Controller 6 determines that such manner of sale is in the best financial interest of the City, such 7 determination to be conclusively evidenced by the execution and delivery of such Purchase 8 Contract as hereinafter approved. The form of such Purchase Contract as presented to this 9 Board of Supervisors, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, is 10 hereby approved. The Controller or the Director of Public Finance is hereby authorized to 11 execute such Purchase Contract with such changes, additions and modifications as the 12 Controller or the Director of Public Finance may make or approve in accordance with Section 13 19 hereof; provided however, that the Underwriters' discount under any such Purchase 14 Contract shall not exceed 1.0% of the principal amount of the Series 2021E Bonds. In order 15 to facilitate the sale of the Series 2021E Bonds by negotiated sale, the Controller or the 16 Director of Public Finance is hereby authorized and directed to appoint one or more financial 17 institutions to act as underwriter for the Series 2021E Bonds.

Section 16. <u>Disposition of Proceeds of Sale</u>. The proceeds of sale of the Series 2021E
 Bonds shall be applied by the City Treasurer as follows: (a) accrued interest, if any, shall be
 deposited into the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount; (b) premium, if any, shall be deposited
 into the Series 2021E Bond Subaccount in such amount not to exceed three years of interest
 on the Series 2021E Bonds; and (c) remaining proceeds of sale shall be deposited into the
 Project Account, including an appropriate subaccount therein.
 Section 17. <u>Preliminary Official Statement and Official Statement</u>. The form of

25 proposed Preliminary Official Statement describing the Series 2021E Bonds ("Preliminary

1 Official Statement") submitted to the Board of Supervisors and on file with the Clerk of the 2 Board of Supervisors is approved and adopted as the Preliminary Official Statement 3 describing the Series 2021E Bonds, with such additions, corrections and revisions as may be 4 determined to be necessary or desirable made in accordance with Section 19. The Controller 5 or the Director of Public Finance is authorized to cause the distribution of a Preliminary Official 6 Statement deemed final for purposes of Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12 7 promulgated under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended ("Rule"), and to sign a 8 certificate to that effect. The Director of Public Finance is authorized and directed to cause to 9 be printed and mailed or electronically distributed to prospective bidders for the Series 2021E 10 Bonds the Preliminary Official Statement in substantially the form of the Preliminary Official 11 Statement approved and adopted by this Resolution, as completed, supplemented, corrected 12 or revised. The Controller or the Director of Public Finance is authorized and directed to 13 approve, execute, and deliver the final Official Statement with respect to the Series 2021E 14 Bonds, which final Official Statement shall be in the form of the Preliminary Official Statement, 15 with such additions, corrections and revisions as may be determined to be necessary or 16 desirable made in accordance with Section 19 and as are permitted under the Rule. The 17 Director of Public Finance is authorized and directed to cause to be signed, printed and 18 mailed or electronically distributed the final Official Statement to all actual initial purchasers of 19 the Series 2021E Bonds.

20 Section 18. <u>Continuing Disclosure Certificate</u>. The form of Continuing Disclosure 21 Certificate ("Continuing Disclosure Certificate"), to be signed by the City to permit the original 22 purchasers of the Series 2021E Bonds to comply with the Rule, submitted to the Board of 23 Supervisors is approved and adopted as the Continuing Disclosure Certificate, with such 24 additions, corrections and revisions as may be determined to be necessary or desirable made 25 in accordance with Section 19. The Controller or the Director of Public Finance is authorized and directed to execute the Continuing Disclosure Certificate on behalf of the City and deliver
 the Continuing Disclosure Certificate to the original purchasers of the Series 2021E Bonds.

3 Section 19. Modification to Documents. Any City official authorized by this Resolution 4 to execute any document is further authorized, in consultation with the City Attorney and co-5 bond counsel, to approve and make such changes, additions, amendments or modifications to 6 the document or documents such official is authorized to execute as may be necessary or 7 advisable (provided, that such changes, additions, amendments or modifications shall not 8 authorize an aggregate principal amount of Series 2021E Bonds in excess of \$90,000,000 or 9 conflict with the provisions of Section 4). The approval of any change, addition, amendment 10 or modification to any of the aforementioned documents shall be evidenced conclusively by 11 the execution and delivery of the document in question.

Section 20. <u>Ratification</u>. All actions previously taken by officials, employees and
 agents of the City with respect to the sale and issuance of the Series 2021E Bonds,
 consistent with any documents presented and this Resolution, are approved, confirmed and
 ratified.

16 Section 21. <u>Relationship to Authorizing Resolution</u>. In the event of any conflict 17 between this Resolution and the Authorizing Resolution, the terms of this Resolution shall 18 control. Without limiting the foregoing and notwithstanding the provisions of the Authorizing 19 Resolution, the City is not obligated to transfer money from the General Fund of the City to the 20 Bond Account to pay the principal of or interest on the Series 2021E Bonds.

Section 22. <u>Accountability Reports</u>. The Series 2021E Bonds are subject to
 accountability requirements under the Administrative Code and the Bond Ordinances. The
 deadline for submission of the Accountability report(s) under Administrative Code
 Sections 2.71(a) and 2.71(b) are hereby waived with respect to the Series 2021E Bonds.

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1 Accountability report(s) with respect to the Series 2021E Bonds shall be submitted in all other 2 respects in the manner required by the Administrative Code and the Bond Ordinances. 3 Section 23. Covenants to Maintain Tax-Exempt Status. The following covenants shall 4 be applicable to any Series 2021E Bonds (including any subseries) issued as bonds the 5 interest on which is excluded from gross income for federal or state income tax purposes: 6 (a) Definitions. When used in this Section, the following terms have the following 7 meanings: 8 "Closing Date" means the date on which the Series 2021E Bonds are first 9 authenticated and delivered to the initial purchasers against payment therefor. 10 "Code" means the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended by all 11 legislation, if any, effective on or before the Closing Date. 12 "Computation Date" has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-1(b) of the 13 Regulations. 14 "Final Computation Date" has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-3(e)(2) of 15 the Regulations. 16 "Gross Proceeds" means any proceeds as defined in Section 1.148-1(b) of the 17 Regulations, and any replacement proceeds as defined in Section 1.148-1(c) of the 18 Regulations, of the Series 2021E Bonds. 19 "Investment" has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-1(b) of the Regulations. 20 "Nonpurpose Investment" means any investment property, as defined in 21 Section 148(b) of the Code, in which Gross Proceeds of the Series 2021E Bonds are invested 22 and which is not acquired to carry out the governmental purposes of the Series 2021E Bonds. 23 "Rebate Amount" has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-1(b) of the 24 Regulations. 25 ///

"Regulations" means any proposed, temporary, or final Income Tax Regulations
issued pursuant to Sections 103 and 141 through 150 of the Code, and 103 of the Internal
Revenue Code of 1954, which are applicable to the Series 2021E Bonds. Any reference to
any specific Regulation shall also mean, as appropriate, any proposed, temporary or final
Income Tax Regulation designed to supplement, amend or replace the specific Regulation
referenced.

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"Yield" of:

8 (i) any Investment has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-5 of the 9 Regulations; and

10 (ii) the Series 2021E Bonds has the meaning set forth in Section 1.148-4 of11 the Regulations.

12 (b) Not to Cause Interest to Become Taxable. The City shall not use, permit the use 13 of, or omit to use Gross Proceeds or any other amounts (or any property the acquisition, 14 construction or improvement of which is to be financed directly or indirectly with Gross 15 Proceeds) in a manner which if made or omitted, respectively, would cause the interest on 16 any Series 2021E Bond to become includable in the gross income, as defined in Section 61 of 17 the Code, of the owner thereof for federal income tax purposes. Without limiting the 18 generality of the foregoing, unless and until the City receives a written opinion of counsel 19 nationally recognized in the field of municipal bond law to the effect that failure to comply with 20 such covenant will not adversely affect the exemption from federal income tax of the interest 21 on any Series 2021E Bond, the City shall comply with each of the specific covenants in this 22 Section.

(c) <u>No Private Use or Private Payments</u>. Except as permitted by Section 141 of the
 Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder, the City shall at all times prior to the final
 payment on the Series 2021E Bonds:

1 (i) exclusively own, operate and possess all property, the acquisition, 2 construction or improvement of which is to be financed or refinanced directly or indirectly with 3 Gross Proceeds of the Series 2021E Bonds, and not use or permit the use of such Gross 4 Proceeds (including all contractual arrangements with terms different than those applicable to 5 the general public) or any property acquired, constructed or improved with such Gross 6 Proceeds in any activity carried on by any person or entity (including the United States or any 7 agency, department and instrumentality thereof) other than a state or local government. 8 unless such use is solely as a member of the general public; and

9 (ii) not directly or indirectly impose or accept any charge or other payment by 10 any person or entity who is treated as using Gross Proceeds of the Series 2021E Bonds or 11 any property the acquisition, construction or improvement of which is to be financed or 12 refinanced directly or indirectly with such Gross Proceeds, other than taxes of general 13 application within the City or interest earned on investments acquired with such Gross 14 Proceeds pending application for their intended purposes.

15 (d) No Private Loan. Except to the extent permitted by Section 141 of the Code and 16 the Regulations and rulings thereunder, the City shall not use Gross Proceeds of the Series 17 2021E Bonds to make or finance loans to any person or entity other than a state or local 18 government. For purposes of the foregoing covenant, such Gross Proceeds are considered 19 to be "loaned" to a person or entity if: (i) property acquired, constructed or improved with such 20 Gross Proceeds is sold or leased to such person or entity in a transaction which creates a 21 debt for federal income tax purposes; (ii) capacity in or service from such property is 22 committed to such person or entity under a take-or-pay, output or similar contract or 23 arrangement; or (iii) indirect benefits, or burdens and benefits of ownership, of such Gross 24 Proceeds or any property acquired, constructed or improved with such Gross Proceeds are 25 otherwise transferred in a transaction which is the economic equivalent of a loan.

(e) <u>Not to Invest at Higher Yield</u>. Except to the extent permitted by Section 148 of
the Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder, the City shall not at any time prior to
the final stated maturity of the Series 2021E Bonds directly or indirectly invest Gross
Proceeds in any Investment, if as a result of such investment the Yield of any Investment
acquired with Gross Proceeds, whether then held or previously disposed of, exceeds the Yield
of the Series 2021E Bonds.

(f) <u>Not Federally Guaranteed</u>. Except to the extent permitted by Section 149(b) of
the Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder, the City shall not take or omit to take
any action which would cause the Series 2021E Bonds to be federally guaranteed within the
meaning of Section 149(b) of the Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder.

(g) <u>Information Reporting</u>. The City shall timely file the information required by
 Section 149(e) of the Code with the Secretary of the Treasury on Form 8038-G or such other
 form and in such place as the Secretary may prescribe.

(h) <u>Rebate of Arbitrage Profits</u>. Except to the extent otherwise provided in Section
148(f) of the Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder:

16 (i) The City shall account for all Gross Proceeds (including all receipts, 17 expenditures and investments thereof) on its books of account separately and apart from all 18 other funds (and receipts, expenditures and investments thereof) and shall retain all records 19 of accounting for at least six years after the day on which the last outstanding Series 2021E 20 Bond is discharged. However, to the extent permitted by law, the City may commingle Gross 21 Proceeds of the Series 2021E Bonds with other money of the City; provided that the City 22 separately accounts for each receipt and expenditure of Gross Proceeds and the obligations 23 acquired therewith.

24 (ii) Not less frequently than each Computation Date, the City shall calculate
 25 the Rebate Amount in accordance with rules set forth in Section 148(f) of the Code and the

Regulations and rulings thereunder. The City shall maintain such calculations with its official
 transcript of proceedings relating to the issuance of the Series 2021E Bonds until six years
 after the Final Computation Date.

4 As additional consideration for the purchase of the Series 2021E Bonds (iii) 5 by the initial purchasers and the loan of the money represented thereby and in order to induce 6 such purchase by measures designed to ensure the excludability of the interest thereon from 7 gross income for federal income tax purposes, the City shall pay to the United States the 8 amount that when added to the future value of previous rebate payments made for the Series 9 2021E Bonds equals (i) in the case of a Final Computation Date, 100% of the Rebate Amount 10 on such date; and (ii) in the case of any other Computation Date, 90% of the Rebate Amount 11 on such date. In all cases, the rebate payments shall be made at the times, in the 12 installments, to the place and in the manner as is or may be required by Section 148(f) of the 13 Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder, and shall be accompanied by Form 8038-T 14 or such other forms and information as is or may be required by Section 148(f) of the Code 15 and the Regulations and rulings thereunder.

(iv) The City shall exercise reasonable diligence to assure that no errors are
made in the calculations and payments required by paragraphs (ii) and (iii), and if an error is
made, to discover and promptly correct such error within a reasonable amount of time
thereafter (and in all events within 180 days after discovery of the error), including payment to
the United States of any additional Rebate Amount owed to it, interest thereon, and any
penalty imposed under Section 1.148-3(h) of the Regulations.

(i) <u>Not to Divert Arbitrage Profits</u>. Except to the extent permitted by Section 148 of
 the Code and the Regulations and rulings thereunder, the City shall not, at any time prior to
 the final payment on the Series 2021E Bonds, enter into any transaction that reduces the
 amount required to be paid to the United States pursuant to Section 25(h) above because

such transaction results in a smaller profit or a larger loss than would have resulted if the
 transaction had been at arm's length and had the Yield of the Series 2021E Bonds not been
 relevant to either party.

4 (j) <u>Elections</u>. The City directs and authorizes the Director of Public Finance and the
5 Controller, either or any combination of them, to make elections permitted or required
6 pursuant to the provisions of the Code or the Regulations, as they deem necessary or
7 appropriate in connection with the Series 2021E Bonds, in the Certificate as to Tax Exemption
8 or similar or other appropriate certificate, form or document.

9 Section 24. <u>City Services Auditor Fee</u>. To the extent permitted by law, one-fifth of one
10 percent (0.2%) of the amount of gross proceeds of the Series 2021E Bonds deposited into the
11 Series 2021E Project Account, as established by the Authorizing Resolution, shall be applied
12 to pay the City Services Auditor Fee.

13 Section 25. General Authority. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, the Mayor, the 14 City Treasurer, the Director of Public Finance, the City Attorney and the Controller are each 15 authorized and directed in the name and on behalf of the City to take any and all steps and to 16 issue, deliver or enter into any and all certificates, requisitions, agreements, notices, consents, 17 and other documents as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Resolution, 18 including but not limited to tax compliance certificates and letters of representations to any 19 depository or depositories, which they or any of them might deem necessary or appropriate in 20 order to consummate the lawful issuance, sale and delivery of the Series 2021E Bonds. Any 21 such actions are solely intended to further the purposes of this Resolution, and are subject in 22 all respects to the terms of this Resolution. No such actions shall increase the risk to the City 23 or require the City to spend any resources not otherwise granted herein. Final versions of any /// 24

The Bonds are issuable as fully registered bonds without coupons in the denominations of \$5,000 or any integral multiple of such amount; provided, that no Bond shall have principal maturing on more than one principal maturity date.
