FY 23 & 24 Capital Budget

- The FY 22 GF Pay Go Program was reduced to 1/3 of previous budget due to COVID impacts, but supplemented by Critical Repairs Program, and G.O. Bond funding for Streets and ROW
- Planned Pay Go Program funding remains low for FY 23 (\$51M) and FY 24 (\$56M), with less supplemental funding to address shortfalls
- Enhancements projects continue to be unfunded
